It has come to the attention of the publisher that the article Wang J, Cao Q, Zhu X (2025), "Privacy disclosure on social media: the role of platform features, group effects, trust and privacy concern". *Library Hi Tech*, Vol. 43 No. 2–3 pp. 1035–1059, doi: <https://doi.org/10.1108/LHT-06-2023-0253>, did not sufficiently report the details of the ethics approval or informed consent for this research within the body of the manuscript. This research was approved by the Institutional Review Board for the School of Tourism, Nanchang University on 10 February 2023 and conducted in accordance with appropriate ethical guidelines. Informed consent was obtained from all participants prior to their participation in the study.
