Referring to Vol.18 No.2 May 2014, the section 2.2 and 2.3 on page 97 will be revised as follows:

2.2 Materials

Five different weft yarns were selected:

- i. 25% cotton /75% polyester yarn of 40/2 cotton count (2x14.8 tex);
- ii. 100% cotton yarn of 40/2 cotton count (2x14.8 tex);
- iii. cotton yarn containing 5.3% Spandex of 15/1 cotton count (39.4 tex);
- iv. cotton yarn containing 6.7% Spandex of 20/2 cotton count (2x29.5 tex); and
- v. cotton yarn containing 3.1% Spandex of 26/1 cotton count (22.7 tex).

One warp was used to produce all of the samples and the warp yarn was 25% cotton/75% polyester of 40/2 cotton count (2x14.8 tex).

2.3 Fabric and Garment Formation

A Tsudakoma shuttle weaving machine was used to produce thirty-three tubular fabrics of different weaves. The warp specifications were:

warp yarn: 25% cotton/75% polyester of 40/2, cotton count (2x14.8 tex)
